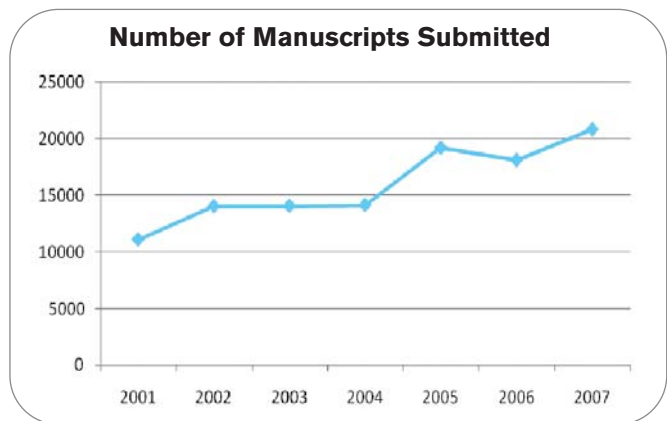
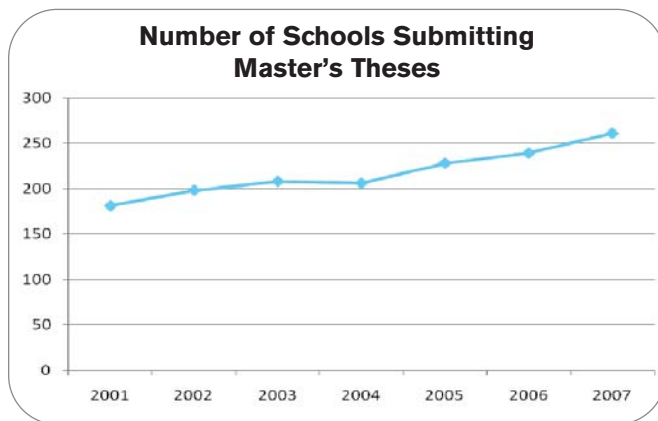


What are the advantages of publishing a Master's Thesis?

- Theses, like dissertations, may help identify and connect national and international networks of research communities
- Dissemination of theses permits the sharing of new knowledge—within and across fields of study
- Wide knowledge of quality theses may strengthen the scholarly profile of your faculty, the graduate programs, and the university
- Published theses can increase the visibility of graduate programs nationally and internationally
